What is the Responsible Gaming Association of New Mexico?

The Responsible Gaming Association of New Mexico (RGANM) is a collaboration of many of the state's Native American owned casinos, who work together to promote awareness of problem gambling and the resources that are available across New Mexico.

RGANM provides educational materials about problem gambling and funds treatment and counseling services. In addition, the group holds an annual conference for treatment providers and counselors, offering continuing education credits for their licensure and ongoing information about the treatment of individuals and their families. More than 400 treatment providers attend the annual conference, usually held in August.



The Responsible Gaming Association of New Mexico funds the Problem Gambling Resource Helpline, a toll free information and referral service. The Helpline is operated for callers concerned with problem gambling related issues or for general information on compulsive gambling. This 24-hour-a-day/7-day-a-week service is a vital link that allows anyone... anywhere... anytime... to reach out for the information or help they need.
